ADDISON FPD REQUIREMENTS

US Citizenship

- No Felony Convictions
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Valid Driver's License
- Between 21 and 35 years of age by date of application, unless otherwise exempt by state statute
- IDPH Certified Paramedic required, unless written request for waiver is approved by the Commission in accordance with their adopted rules.
 - Contact the Addison Fire Department for information on the waiver (630)628-3100
 - Request for waiver must meet the following criteria:
 - The applicant is currently in paramedic training
 - The applicant is expected to graduate and be granted a license by the IDPH as a certified paramedic within the six (6) month period following the posting date of a new eligibility register.
- The CPAT verification passage card must be dated no earlier than one year before the date of application and no later than the date of the written examination

ADDISON FPD Documents Required

- Copy of Valid Driver's License
- Copy of High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Copy of County or State Birth Certificate (hospital copies will not be accepted) *If you were not born in the United States, you must provide a copy of your Certificate of Naturalization Citizenship or a copy of your VALID US PASSPORT at the orientation along with other required documents.
- Copy of IDPH Paramedic Certificate, unless written request for waiver is approved by the Commission in accordance with their adopted rules.
- If no Paramedic Certificate, a copy of the signed waiver from the Addison Fire Department shall be submitted at orientation.
- Copy of CPAT certificate dated no earlier than one year before the date of application and no later than the date of the written examination
